

Finding the Music Alphabet on the Guitar: A Worksheet

1. The music alphabet uses A B C D E F G, then begins again with A.
2. All letters are two frets apart *except B to C, and E to F*, which are *one* fret apart.

The distance of one fret is called a “half-step.”
The distance of two frets is called a “whole-step.”

- *Write the letters on the correct frets on this tablature (“picture”) of the first twelve frets.*
- *Circled numbers are string numbers.*
